3. A. 11 x 8.5 piece of paper with the ARTWORK ONLY

(11 inches wide and 8.5 tall).

OR

3. B. ARTWORK and WRITING (if your classroom requires this contest to host a writing element). 11 x 8.5 piece of paper with Artwork

(7 inches wide x 8.5 tall with the writing element 4 inches wide x 8.5 tall) *

The **<u>ARTWORK</u>** is to depict a boat the student has seen in the parade or one they wish to see in the parade.

- PLEASE USE BRIGHT COLORS using colored markers, paint, crayons, pencils and/or cut-outs from colored paper. <u>DO NOT USE GLITTER.</u>
- * IF YOU ARE ADDING WRITING: The **DESIGN FEATURE** explains a unique feature of your boat. This unique feature could be anything from a safety feature for the occupants or the boat to an enhancement feature that makes your boat stand out during the parade. Use your imagination and be creative.
 - You must explain what your feature is and how it will improve your boat design.
 - The explanation must be no longer than a paragraph and be written legibly. It may be typed.
 - You may include a labeled pen or pencil drawing (diagram) of the unique feature.

4. All work must be mailed to Winterfest, Inc. (512 Northeast 3rd Avenue, Fort Lauderdale, FL 33301) by January **15**, **2020**.
